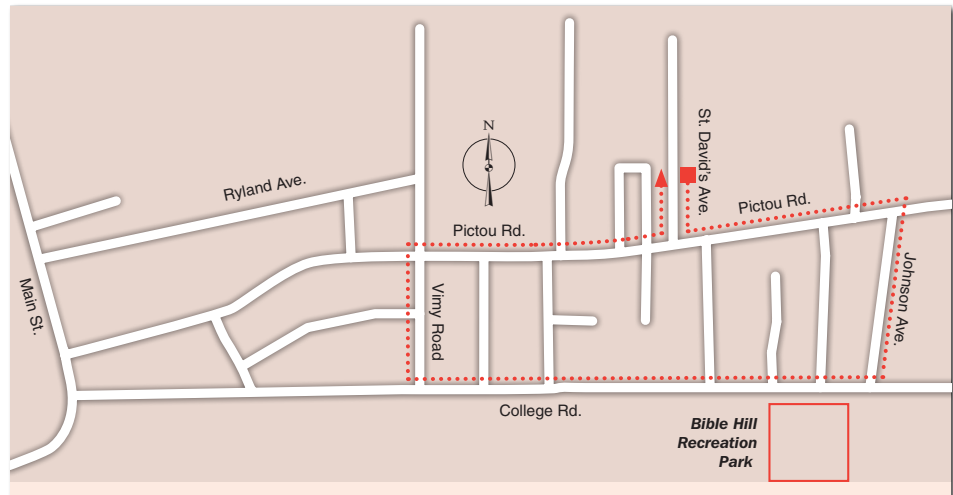

Street Parade: It is that time of year again to celebrate Canada's birthday! This year the Village of Bible Hill is promoting the theme "*Dalhousie University's 200th Anniversary*" for the street parade. Dal's colours are Black and Gold, parade entrants are encouraged to decorate with this theme in mind.

The Grand Street Parade begins at 10:30am. It will start from St. David's Avenue, turning left onto Pictou Road. From there the parade will be turning right onto Johnson Avenue, and then another right onto College Road. The parade will continue onto Vimy Road, right onto Pictou Road and back to St. David's Avenue.

between NOON AND 4:00pm.

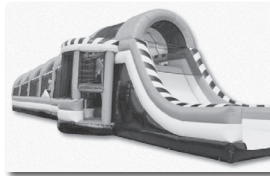
