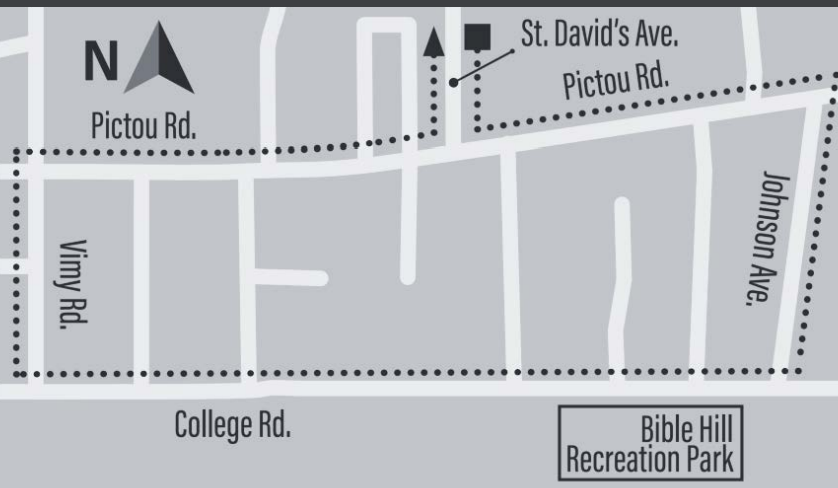

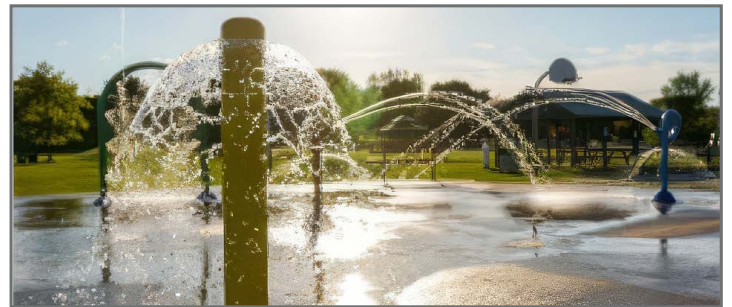


### Park Celebrations

## Public consultation regarding potential sale of properties

The Village is considering selling certain properties. This may:

- (1) allow for new housing to be built (where applicable);
- (2) allow the Village to re-focus maintenance duties from multiple small green-spaces to larger recreation spaces (such as Bible Hill Recreation Park, Holy Well Park, & Airport Field Park);
- (3) provide funding to the Village for other capital use(s).

We are conducting an online survey, intended to collect feedback from Bible Hill residents and in particular those who rent or own property near the following properties:

- (1) - Lot 22 Guest Drive, (2) - 27 Teakwood Court, (3) - 65 Armstrong Avenue, (4) - 23 Maple Boulevard, (5) - 27 Clover Drive, (6) - 22 Fielding Avenue, (7) - 42 Murdock Drive, and (8) - Lot 160 College Road

The Village is seeking community feedback. No decision on this matter has been made, no purchase offers are being accepted, and a timeframe for consideration of the subject by the Commission has not yet been identified. Village staff will be taking the results of this feedback process to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee for review, which may or may not be followed by review and consideration by the Village Commission.
