Golden Long-term Service Award

The Golden Long Term Service Award is presented to those residents of Bible Hill who have made contributions through worldwide community volunteer service for a period of fifty (50) years or longer of which at least twenty-five (25) years of the volunteer service took place in the Village of Bible Hill.

Long-term Service Award

The Long-term Service Award is presented to those residents of Bible Hill who have made contributions through worldwide community volunteer service for a period of twenty-five (25) years or longer of which at least twelve (12) years of the volunteer service took place in the Village of Bible Hill.

Young Achievers Service Award

The Young Achievers Service Award is presented to a Bible Hill Youth (aged eighteen (18) or younger) who has made an outstanding contribution in volunteer community service in Bible Hill in the past year. There is no limit to the number of awards presented each year, or the number of times a person may receive the award.

Outstanding Community Service Award

The Outstanding Community Service Award is presented to those who have made an outstanding contribution in volunteer community service in Bible Hill in the past year. The volunteer may reside inside, or outside of the Village of Bible Hill. There is no limit to the number of awards presented each year, or the number of times a person may receive the award.

Generations of Volunteering Award

Presented to a Bible Hill family with two or more generations that have a combined fifteen (15) or more years of service, with each member contributing at least five (5) years. They may volunteer in one organization or for many, together or separately. It is the family culture and commitment to the community that this award focuses on. Only one (1) family will be chosen per year at the Village's discretion, and each family may receive the award only once.
